



Position – Part-time Lecturer (12-month)

The Department of Curriculum and Pedagogy (EDCP) at the University of British Columbia invites applications for a part-time (50%) 12-month Lecturer in Physical Education. The appointment is expected to commence September 1, 2013.

The Department of Curriculum & Pedagogy (EDCP) is committed to advancing research into curriculum and pedagogy in a variety of contexts and across the lifespan. Our mission is to provide local, national, and international leadership in discipline-specific and interdisciplinary approaches to teaching and learning. Our research supports commitments to the study of curriculum and pedagogy in school, post-secondary, community, and informal learning contexts.

The applicant will have earned doctoral degree in education, experience teaching in K-12 schools, demonstrated effectiveness in teaching courses in one or more of the program areas of Physical Education, Health and Outdoor Education. Preference will be given to applicants who are familiar with the BC education context, who have a K-12 teaching certificate, who have experience in one or more of the above listed program areas, who have experience with inquiry-based teaching and facilitating collaborative curriculum inquiry, and who are committed to bringing diverse critical perspectives to education.

The successful applicant will be expected to (a) teach in Faculty/EDCP undergraduate programs (and possibly EDCP graduate programs); (b) supervise teacher candidates on practicum or in field experience courses; and (c) represent EDCP on relevant Faculty of Education committees, as required. The successful applicant may also be asked to assist in the coordination of EDCP teacher education courses, and to exercise leadership in teacher education curriculum/program development. The position will involve teaching in the teacher education program.

Review of applications will start from August 7, 2013 and will continue until the positions are filled.
