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Position – Secondment in Business Education (12-month)

The successful candidate should also be able to provide leadership in the undergraduate program. Responsibilities will include teaching in the teacher education program, and the diploma and certificate programs in Business Education. The position will also include supervision of teacher candidates, and some administrative duties involving the secondary Business Education program. UBC provides orientation, mentoring and support for instructors who are new to teaching at the university level.

Review of applications will start from May 15, 2013 and will continue until the position is filled.
